

# Apteco Integrations Adestra Setup Guide

A bit about the broadcaster



Upland Adestra was formerly called Adestra

## **Before You Begin**

#### **CAUTION**

This guide details the steps required to integrate Apteco with a Broadcaster using an API; the configuration is in two parts:

- 1. Configuration in your broadcaster, this document.
- 2. The configuration of the Apteco Marketing Suite, which is covered in the online help



You need to configure Upland Adestra before you perform the integration in Apteco, this document is an overview of the broadcaster setup process, it is not intended to be an in-depth broadcaster setup document, please see the documentation provided by Upland Adestra

#### Note:

We take care to keep the information up to date. There may be changes to the broadcaster's API not reflected here. If in doubt, contact your support department or the broadcaster for more information.

### **Useful to have before you start:**

- The Variables or Virtual Variables in FastStats to map to broadcast fields
- The Upland Adestra UI URL, Account Name, Username, and Password to log in to your broadcaster
- The Upland Adestra **Message** name (available from the Upland UI)
- The API URL <a href="https://new.adestra.com/api/xmlrpc">https://new.adestra.com/api/xmlrpc</a>
- The Upland Adestra <u>API</u> Username and Password
   (The API Username is a combination of the above AccountName.Username)
- The \*Username/s to associate with a broadcast in Apteco
- The FTP URL for uploading to Upland Adestra
   (Either your own FTP location or the Upland Adestra provided Client FTP URL)
- The Upland Workspace, Core Table name and Data Table name

## **Upland Adestra Configuration**


Upland Adestra works on the principle of having a database to store the lists you upload, you will need a Core Table and a Data Table setup in your Upland account. Apteco will upload a list of subscribers and insert them into the Upland tables.

If you wish to automatically broadcast the list to a message from Apteco, you need to create a Workspace, Project, and a Campaign with a message within

<sup>\*</sup>You can create individual users within Upland Adestra to associate with a broadcast

Upland Adestra. Also to collect responses you will need to set up an Export to create a Report.

Sign in to your Upland Adestra account to access the web-based control panel

## **Tables in Upland**

You will need the following tables:

## **Core Table (Required)**

This table stores the main communication parameters, it is referenced in the Broadcaster's Plugin Upload Template as Core Table

### **Data Table**

This table stores additional parameters for Apteco and any custom fields, it is referenced in the Broadcaster's Plugin Upload Template as Supplemental Table Example Data Table Fields



## Setting up a Campaign in Upland

• From: **Campaigns** go to workspaces > Administration > Create Workspace




The Create Workspace page opens

- Enter a **Name** for the Workspace and customize using the options.
- If a Workspace exists select the Workspace that you wish to create the campaign in. You will reference this workspace in the configuration within Apteco.


#### Note:

Upland will prompt you for all the required settings, the status area on the right will display your configuration progress.



For example, you will also need to specify a List


 You can either select the Project that you wish to create the campaign in or create a new project by clicking Create Project



• From: **Project** go to Administration > Create Campaign




 Enter a Campaign name and choose a colour to easily identify the campaign if required.



### Once complete, click Save


• Configure the **Campaign options** as appropriate for your message.




### Note:

You will need to specify the Unsubscribe handling options to complete the process.


• Add the content to your message and personalize it with fields from the **Core** or Data tables as appropriate.



- You will also need to select a mailing list, when all the required options have been configured the **Test and Launch** button displays.
- Before you can run a campaign from Apteco, you need to publish the message.




- Click Test and Launch and select step 4 Setup Launch
- Select the Publish Only tab and click Publish Campaign
