Optimizely was formerly called **Episerver** and before that **Optivo** 

## **Before You Begin**

#### **CAUTION**

This guide details the steps required to integrate Apteco with a Broadcaster using an API; the configuration is in two parts:

- 1. Configuration in your broadcaster, this document.
- 2. The configuration of the Apteco Marketing Suite, which is covered in the online help



You need to configure Optimizely before you perform the integration in Apteco, this document is an overview of the broacaster setup process, it is not intended to be an in-depth setup document.

#### Note:

We take care to keep information up to date. There may be changes to the broadcaster's API not reflected here. If in doubt, contact your support department or the broadcaster for more information.

### **Useful to have before you start:**

- The Variables or Virtual Variables in FastStats to map to broadcast fields
- The Optimizely UI URL Username, Password and PIN to log in to your broadcaster
- The Optimizely List Name and Message Name (available from the Episerver UI)
- · The Optimizely API Username and Password
- The Optimizely Client ID

# **Optimizely Configuration**

#### Note:

If you wish to automatically broadcast the list to a message from Apteco, you need to create a message within Optimizely using a Smart Campaign.

Login to your Optimizely account to access the web-based control panel





## **Recipients**

For initial testing you should create a Recipient list that includes yourself, you can either create a recipient or Import a recipient to a list.

Recipients List in Optimizely







## **Smart Campaign**


• Create a Smart Campaign with the following minimum items




- Connect the steps
