

Apteco Integrations Emarsys Setup Guide

Helping you to get the most out of the Apteco Marketing Suite

Before You Begin

CAUTION

This guide details the steps required to integrate Apteco with a Broadcaster using an API; the configuration is in two parts:

- 1. Configuration in your broadcaster, this document.
- 2. The configuration of the Apteco Marketing Suite, which is covered in the online help



You need to configure Emarsys before you perform the integration in Apteco, this document is an overview of the broadcaster setup process, it is not intended to be an in-depth broadcaster setup document, please see the documentation provided by Emarsys

Note:

We take care to keep the information up to date. There may be changes to the broadcaster's API not reflected here. If in doubt, contact your support department or the broadcaster for more information.

Useful to have before you start:


- The Variables or Virtual Variables in FastStats to map to broadcast fields
- The Emarsys UI URL Account, Username and Password to log in to your broadcaster
- The Emarsys Message (Campaign) and List name (That you create in the Emarsys UI)
- · The Emarsys API Username and Password
- The Emarsys API Key and Secret (available from the Emarsys UI)
- The FTP Username and Password (available from the Emarsys UI)

Emarsys Configuration

Apteco uploads a list of subscribers and inserts them into the Emarsys List

If you wish to automatically broadcast the list to a message either from Apteco, you need to create a message within Emarsys.

 Login to your Emarsys account to access the web-based control panel using the account-specific URL provided by Emarsys

Creating a new Message in Emarsys

• From Contacts > Contact Lists either click **Create Contact List** you do not need to add subscribers as Apteco uploads a list of subscribers.

You need to create a Campaign Email (Message) to use in Apteco.

 From Campaigns > Email Campaigns click Create Email step through the wizard to create a basic email and assign it to a Contact List
